

WANAKI JUNIOR GOLF DIVISIONS-2018

In order to maximize the enjoyment of the golf game at Wanaki on Monday's for your son or daughter, while helping increase the pace of play, the staff at Wanaki has decided to create 4-separate divisions, with assigned division tee-times scheduled accordingly.

All League members (except for the 18-hole Division), will be required to attend a pre-season orientation meeting where expectations and goals for the players will be covered. This information will be sent with the Junior League tee-time confirmation the first week of April.

***Please note that entire groups must sign up in the same division, and if, for car-pooling purposes, we will attempt to get groups as close together as we can.

PLEASE READ ALL DIVISIONS CAREFULLY AND CHOOSE WHICH EVER ONE YOU FEEL MEETS YOUR GROUPS NEEDS. IF YOU ARE HAVING A DIFFICULT TIME DETERMINING A DIVISION, PLEASE CONTACT WANAKI FOR ASSISTANCE.

18 HOLE PLAYERS (9:30- 10:30)- These are experienced golfers who may be interested in playing Tournament Golf, or who are planning on or are already playing High School Golf. These golfers always keep an accurate score and attempt to improve every time they play. They understand and play by the rules, and are very interested in improving their game and score. Attending the League Orientation is optional for this division. This group will play the white tees.

9-HOLE EXPERIENCED PLAYERS (10:30-1:00)- These are experienced golfers who always attempt to keep an accurate score when they play golf. The average score for this player is 60 or better. This player has played a fair amount of 9-hole rounds, and has the ability to maneuver around the golf course with very little supervision. The goal for this player is to improve their score every week. This group will play the Red Tees. League orientation is Mandatory.

NOVICE 9-HOLE PLAYERS (1:00-2:30)- This player has played a few rounds with adult supervision, has been to the driving range, and has maybe taken a few lessons. They do not regularly keep score and most likely would shoot over 60 for 9-holes. They have not played unsupervised, but are mature enough to follow along with the general golf rules and etiquette while they keep pace with the group in front of them. This group will play a mix of the Red Tees and The Junior Tees. League Orientation is Mandatory.

PAR 3 PLAYERS 7 HOLES (1:00-2:30)- Wanaki is a long challenging Championship Golf Course that is simply too much for our newer and younger players. We have created a Fantastic 7-hole option for the players just beginning to learn the game. The holes will range from 100-150 yards each, and will give the same challenges and obstacles that the other youngsters play. These players will gain the experience of playing a game without being overwhelmed by the length and challenges of a regulation course. This group will play the junior Tees. League Orientation is Mandatory.

PLEASE DETERMINE WHICH DIVISION BEST FITS THE NEEDS OF YOUR GROUP, AND IDENTIFY ACCORDINGLY WHEN SUBMITTING YOUR REGISTRATION. WE ARE STRIVING TO MAKE THIS JUNIOR DAY THE BEST POSSIBLE TO ENHANCE THE ENJOYMENT AND APPRECIATION OF THE GAME. WE RESERVE THE RIGHT TO MOVE GROUPS TO AN APPROPRIATE LEVEL IF CIRCUMSTANCES DICTATE THAT A MOVE IS NECESSARY.
